## WHAT:

**"Grab & Go" breakfast and lunch. Meals for the weekend will be available on Fridays.**

## WHEN:

**Monday through Friday, 12 noon to 2 pm**

## HOW:

**Students or families can drive through or walk up.**

Meals are distributed by foodservice staff trained in health and safety procedures. Security guards assist with maintaining social distancing (6 feet apart).
