

FREE MEALS FOR CHILDREN

While schools are closed during the COVID-19 coronavirus public health crisis, free meals for children are available for pick up at locations throughout the city. In these difficult times, all families who need assistance with making sure children have enough to eat are welcome to participate in this free program.

WHO:

Norwalk children, ages 2-18. Children do not have to be enrolled in Norwalk Public Schools.

WHAT:

“Grab & Go” breakfast and lunch. Meals for the weekend will be available on Fridays.

WHEN:

Monday through Friday, 12 noon to 2 pm

HOW:

Students or families can drive through or walk up.

Meals are distributed by foodservice staff trained in health and safety procedures. Security guards assist with maintaining social distancing (6 feet apart).
