

Advancing Norwalk Children on the Path to Economic and Social Mobility


"Working together, everything is achievable"

This Norwalk goal to change lives will help us:

- **Motivate:** Clear progress in real lives impacted, not just systems.
- Align: Shared metrics unite schools, nonprofits, and community partners toward one vision.
- **Sustain:** Measurable goals and achievements attract lasting investment and resources.

When young people meet key cradle-to-career milestones — from kindergarten readiness to employment — they are far more likely to achieve economic and social mobility: the ability to build economic success, power, and autonomy while feeling valued in their community. Each milestone compounds opportunity, and each missed milestone deepens inequity.
